Nature of planned support 2014 /15

The indicative funding has been planned to be allocated in the following ways:

- Focused in class support for Pupil Premium & Looked after Pupils.
- Increased teacher and teaching assistant support to develop and implement “Reading Write Inc” and RM maths throughout school.
- Develop and implement teacher and teaching assistant support to raise the attainment of mathematical & writing using practical strategies.
- Subsidise the cost of educational visits and extra curricular activities for Free School meal Pupils to encourage full participation.
- Subsidise the cost of Breakfast and After School Clubs.
- Increase classroom support and provide a designated PPG teaching assistant.

Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2014/15

The School focused its additional and targeted support from a teacher or teaching assistant in phonics, reading, writing (Read Write Inc) and mathematics (RM maths resources).
